

Fitzwilliam Primary Key Skill Development

The following 6 key skills have been identified as significant attributes that our school curriculum will seek to develop within all children from Foundation Stage to Year 6. The key skills will be developed through the application of basic skills across the curriculum but the aim is to also ensure that the key skills permeate throughout all aspects of a child's education and social development.

The identified key skills are not hierarchical and all have equal importance. Each identified key skill has attributes which will support the development of the skill.

One skill per week is highlighted in Monday assembly, the weekly skill will be displayed on each classroom door and Friday Golden Work Certificates link to the weekly skill.
