Design and Make

- A treasure map.
- A sail boat/rocket.
- A treasure chest.
- An explorer's back pack of tools.

Write

- Instructions to find the treasure.
- A captain's log to share what they have found out.
- A postcard home to tell others about your exploration.
- A recipe to make a healthy explorer's lunch.

Find out (Books/Internet)

- Who is Neil Armstrong/Tim Peake/Blackbeard/Christopher Columbus?
- Where did these famous explorers travel to? Make a map.
- How long did it take the explorers to find their amazing discoveries?

Enquiry - present your reasons.

- How many different treasures are important to you and why?
- Ask your grown-ups to share photographs that they treasure with you.
- What makes the perfect treasure?
- Who do you think is the best explorer and why?
